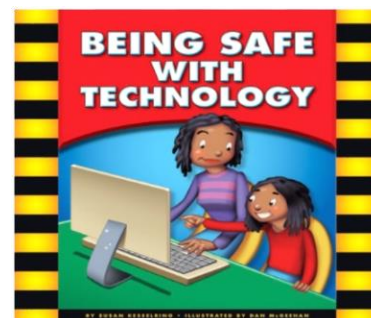
We look forward to hosting more events in the future considering we have all this great space to enjoy!
