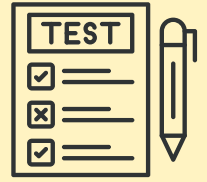

Regular school attendance is critical to students' educational achievement, well-being, and overall development. Evidence, including recent ESRI research, highlights the long-term impact of absence.

When our children miss school, they miss out on learning, social development and valuable time with their friends and teachers.

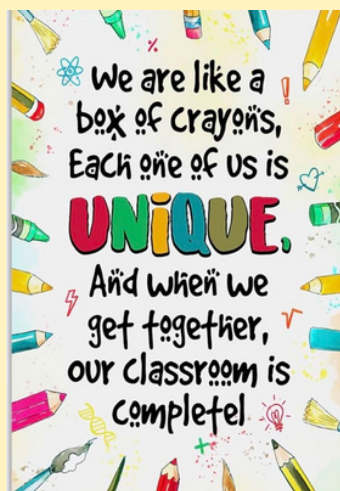
School starts at 8.30 am. Roll-taking is carried out early in the morning. Punctuality and regular attendance are key factors in your child's education. Even small amounts of lateness or leaving early can add up to a significant loss of learning time over a school year.

Parents must be informed of their child's attendance record throughout the year.

Letters are sent via email after 10, 15 and 20 days absence.

Please keep letting us know details of all absences by email. The school is obliged, by law, to inform Tusla when a pupil is absent for 20 school days in one school year, regardless of the reason. As the school has to fill in the category of absence when informing Tusla, an email or written note must be sent in after every absence explaining the reasons for the absence
